

*Baptisia Australis* (False Indigo, Wild Blue Indigo)

I encourage you to grow this 3' perennial in a frame so it doesn't flop. It will reseed to other parts of your garden, but I would not call it invasive. Cut back in late fall. Seed heads dry and are lovely in dried arrangements. It attracts pollinators . Other cultivars can be obtained in yellow and pink/white.
