

*Companula glomerata* 'Joan Elliott' (Bellflower)

*Companula* are a large family of flowers ranging from creeping groundcovers to 3' tall and everything in between. They are easy to grow in full sun or part shade and may be divided after several years in spring or fall. Remove spent flower stalks to encourage rebloom and cut back to ground in winter. Joan Elliott tends to cluster flowers at the top and looks good in mass plantings in the border. The color is a delphinium blue – purple.
